

#### DAY 2 | BOLU -> 380km 4h -> ANKARA -> 250km 3h -> CAPPADOCIA

Today, Departure to Cappadocia via Ankara is the capital city of Turkey and the country's second largest city after Istanbul. The city has a population (as of 2019) of 5,5 million, and a mean elevation of 850 m (2800 ft). It was formerly known as Angora. The Hittites gave it the name Ankuwash before 1200 BC, the Galatians and Romans called it Ancyra, and in the classical, Hellenistic, and Byzantine periods it was known as Ankyra. Ankara also serves as the capital of the Province of Ankara then continue to Cappadocia where is A moonscape region carved by the nature and men, Cappadocia is most famous for its unique geological features and layers of history. Cappadocia is the name of the region created by the erosion of the soft layers formed by the lava and ashes sprayed by the volcanic mountains of Erciyes, Hasandağ and Güllüdağ, and shaped by rain, wind, and ice for millions of years. As the landscape was eroded, basalt stones remained and formed conical structures with some reaching as high as 45 m were created over time by erosion of the relatively soft volcanic ash around them. Past cultures have dug into them to create dwellings, castles, and even entire underground cities, used as hiding places by early inhabitants. The local people referred to these unique rock formations as "fairy chimneys", a name that has endured throughout the ages. If nature was the first artist to arrange the decor, it was Anatolian humankind who carved the rock and created Cappadocia as an open-air museum full of unparalleled natural and cultural phenomena. Cappadocia, "the land of beautiful horses" as one interpretation of the name Katpatuka suggests, is the key to the myriad potential possibilities for exploring and experiencing this fantastic land, from riding to cycling, from exploration to sumptuous cuisine. No matter the season or time of year, this fantasy land has something to stimulate, captivate and invigorate the senses. Cappadocia is one of those places, allowing you to leave our planet behind without leaving it. Given a chance, these lands will not quit on you...

#### **Anitkabir (Mausoleum of Ataturk)**

No one is more respected in Turkey as much as Mustafa Kemal Ataturk, the founder of modern Turkish Republic. Even his political opponents who are always is charge mainly to destroy his secularity revolution, can not dare to speak against him. Ataturk's mausoleum. Anıtkabir is located on an imposing hill in the Anıttepe quarter of the city, where the mausoleum of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, founder of the Republic of Turkey, stands. Completed in 1953, it is an impressive fusion of ancient and modern architectural styles. An adjacent museum houses a wax statue of Atatürk, his writings, letters and personal items, as well as an exhibition of photographs recording important moments in his life and during the establishment of the Republic. Anıtkabir is open every day, while the adjacent museum is open every day except Mondays.

#### Tuz Golu (Salt Lake)

Tuz Golu in Turkish, is a saline lake occupying a huge area in the arid central plateau of Turkey, about 105 kilometers (65 miles) northeast of Konya, neighboring also Nigde and Ankara provinces. It's the second largest lake of Turkey, after Lake Van, lying at an elevation of 905 meters (2,970 feet) as a tectonic lake. Despite it's huge area (1500 square kilometers / 580 square miles) for most of the year is very shallow (between 0,5-1 meters), especially during dry summer months when the water evaporates in huge quantities leaving a tick crust of salt on the surface up to 30 centimeters. This salt is extracted, worked, refined and sold in the local market, thus making this the biggest industry for small towns' economy in the area. It's not only the biggest salt lake of Turkey but one of the biggest in the world as well. The density of the water is 1.225 gr/cm3, and salt percentage is 32.4%. The lake has no outlet, and only few surface streams feed it but they dry in the summer when the climate is hot. Rainfall in the surrounding area is as low as 250 milimeters (10 inches) per year. There are also many small lakes around the Tuz Gölü; Kulu Lake, Samsam Lake, Uyuz Lake, Kozanli Saz Lake, Boluk Lake, Tersakan Lake, Esmekaya Lake and Hirfanli Dam Lake.

#### Cappadocia, Pigeon Valley

Pigeon Valley earned its name from the countless man-made dovecotes (Pigeon Houses) that have been carved into the soft volcanic tuff. While pigeons no longer play such an important role in the area, their rocky homes have still been maintained by locals.



#### DAY 3 | CAPPADOCIA

Rise and shine, it will be an early start for our optional sunrise hot air balloon ride over the stunning landscapes and fairy chimneys of Cappadocia. Or if preferred enjoy a leisurely start to the morning before we all fill up on breakfast. which has been selected as one of the top ten most beautiful places on earth by the American "National Geographic" magazine. It is one of the three most suitable places on earth for hot air ballooning. You will also have the chance to taste Turkish special pistachio ice cream and Turkish black tea. We will explore the UNESCO World Heritage listed Goreme open Air Museum, and tick off bucket list sights along the way including Göreme Musuem, Pigeon Valley, Uchisar and Cavusin. Tonight, get your dancing shoes on for our optional Turkish Night.

hidden churches, and underground cities along with luxurious cave hotels. The nearby tourist town of Goreme is small and beautiful with sophisticated infrastructure. The surrounding area around is filled with a magical scenery and offers beautiful long walks through enchanting places.

#### **Uchisar Castle**

Uchisar Castle is located in the town of Uchisar, and stands proudly as the highest point in Cappadocia

Goreme Open Air Museum in the Goreme Valley as Photostop The Göreme Open Air Museum is a crown jewel in Cappadocia's rich history! This small area contains the best churches in Cappadocia and several monastic complexes. In 1985, the Göreme Open Air Museum was recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site to conserve and properly display Cappadocia's best cave churches.

#### Kaymaklı Underground City

Cappadocia is filled with surprises by mother nature! Underground cities are by far the most jawdropping. They are hidden beneath the moonscape topography of this magical region and there are 36 total underground cities. For centuries, these magnificent structures have hosted Cappadocians and provided them with a haven from those who sought their destruction.

#### **Fairy Chimneys**

Fairy Chimneys are the world-famous formations of Cappadocia. The outstanding landscape, natural beauties, rock-cut houses, caves, picturesque valleys, and many more popular spots of Cappadocia are full of these unusual and amazing formations.





# DAY 4 | CAPPADOCIA -> 250km 3h -> KONYA -> 450km 5h -> PAMUKKALE

Today, we will drive to Konya, the capital of ancient Türkiye in the 13th century. Konya is located in central Türkiye and is one of the oldest urban centers in the world. Along the way we will stop at Konya for lunch then continue to Pamukkale . when arrive to Pamukkale, Get your cameras ready, as it is time to visit Pamukkale, or 'cotton castle' in Turkish. Pamukkale is a natural site that contains hot springs and travertine, giving the appearance of terraces made by carbonate minerals left by the flowing water. The ancient city of Hierapolis was built on top of the white castle and people have bathed in its pools for thousands of years . After tour, time to rest up at our overnight stay in Pamukkale.

#### Sultanhani Carvansarai

The Sultanhan caravanserai was built in 1229 by Seljuk sultan Alaeddin Keykubad I when Aksaray was an important stopover along the Silk Road that crossed through Anatolia. After suffering partial destruction in a fire, the building was restored and extended in 1278 under the reign of sultan Kaykhusraw III. The monumental caravanserai then became one of the best examples of Anatolian Seljuk architecture. The caravanserai enjoyed its glory times during the Seljuk period, but lost its importance during the Ottoman era. More recent restorations were made during the Republic period and opened to visitors.

#### **Hierapolis & Cotton Castle**

The sacred Hierapolis of Phrygia is one of the antique cities of the Aegean! It was placed on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1988. One of the most important sights of Hierapolis Türkiye is an ancient theater that is located on the hillside. The building is constructed of solid rock and the overall height of its steps is about one hundred meters. Fifty rows separated by walkways on seven sectors are seats for spectators. After the completion of the constructions works, the theater could accommodate about ten thousand people. Here you can also see the Hierapolis ruins of the Temple of Apollo.



# DAY 5 | PAMUKKALE -> 250km 3h -> KUSADASI

Today, we will go to Kusadasi (Bird Island), a resort on the Aegean Sea at the western end of Türkiye.

On arrive to Ephesus. visit ancient city of Ephesus. Ephesus was cited in the book of Revelations, and historians believe the Gospel of John was written here. Famed for the Temple of Artemis which was completed around 550 BC and is one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. After dinner, you can stroll along the Aegean Sea and enjoy the sunset.

#### **Ephesus Ancient City**

Ephesus was an ancient port city whose well-preserved ruins are in modern-day Turkey. The city was once considered the most important Greek city and the most important trading center in the Mediterranean region. Throughout history, Ephesus survived multiple attacks and changed hands many times between conquerors. It was also a hotbed of early Christian evangelism and remains an important archaeological site and Christian pilgrimage destination.

#### The House of Virgin Mary

The belief that the Virgin Mary had spent her last days in the vicinity of Ephesus and that she had died there, focused attention on a nun named Anna Katherina Emmerich who had livid in the late 18th century (1774-1820). The efforts to find the house were greatly influenced by her detailed description of the Virgin Mary's coming to Ephesus, her life and her last home there and the characteristics of the city although she had never been to Ephesus.





# DAY 6 | KUSADASI -> 300km 3h -> BERGAMA -> 200km 2h -> CANAKKALE

Today, we will drive Pergamum, and the ruins of the Asklepion, an ancient healing centre then continue to the ancient port by the Dardanelles - Canakkale (the ancient city of Troy). Here, we will visit the magnificent Big Trojan Horse and the historical relics of the ancient city of Troy! This city was based on a piece of historical relic that has been passed down through the ages. It is best described by the blind poet Homer - the Trojan Horse Massacre.

#### **Topkapi Palace**

Set on top of the most visible hill of Istanbul, Topkapi Palace. This location is the symbol of the city.

The rich history of this place offers visitors a chance to get to know the Sultans of the Ottoman Empire. It is made up of four different



courtyards and various exhibitions such as the treasury, weapons, watch collection, kaftans, portraits, and sacred relics of prophets.

#### **Sultanahmet Square**

The Sultanahmet Square is the old historic quarter of Istanbul and here you will find some of the most significant historic monuments of Istanbul. Facing the Blue Mosque at the opposite end of the square is the magnificent Hagia Sophia. There's not much left of this stadium, but significant monuments here include the Obelisk of Theodosius, the Serpentine Column and the Column of Constantine.

There's also a pretty domed fountain commemorating the visit of Kaiser Wilhelm II to Istanbul in 1898.

#### Obelisk of Theodosius (Dikilitaş)

In 1500 BC, it was built under Pharaoh Thutmose III as a memorial stone for the victory in Mesopotamia and placed in front of the temple of Karnak in Luxor. In 390, the Byzantine Emperor Theodosius I brought the granite obelisk from Luxor into the city and had it stationed at Hippodrome Square. It is supported by four bronze cubes and in the lower area is a pedestal made of marble. The bas-relief shows, among other things, images of Emperor Theodosius, the traditional chariot races and the construction of the obelisk. Latin and ancient Greek inscriptions can be found on all sides.

#### **Blue Mosque**

Explore the Blue Mosque and its spectacular beauty! It has five main domes, six minarets and eight secondary domes. It is a one-of-a-kind unique place to discover and something you must visit at least once in your life.
